EDUCATION

Choose this focus area to invest in Central Texas children and youth. Our work fills gaps to ensure students receive critical services during their early and middle school years. Last year, UWCA served more than 14,000 students and families with support services including parent education, in-service training for childcare staff, quality assessments of afterschool programs, and mentoring and tutoring programs.



INCOME

Choose this focus area to aid financial education and stability initiatives. Our work connects low-income individuals to services such as job training, educational programs, and financial coaching. To help increase income, the UWCA Helpline referred more than 6,000 people to free tax assistance centers to file Earned Income Tax Credit claims. The result was \$29 million in refunds in 2011.



HEALTH

Choose this focus area to address healthcare gaps for older adults, and low-income working families. Our efforts connect adults and children with primary and preventative care, chronic disease management and behavioral health services. In partnership with Central Health, the UWCA Helpline now serves as a clearinghouse for information, eligibility screening, and intake appointments for state healthcare programs for the uninsured and under-insured.
